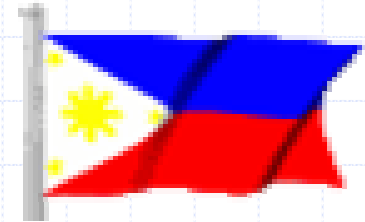

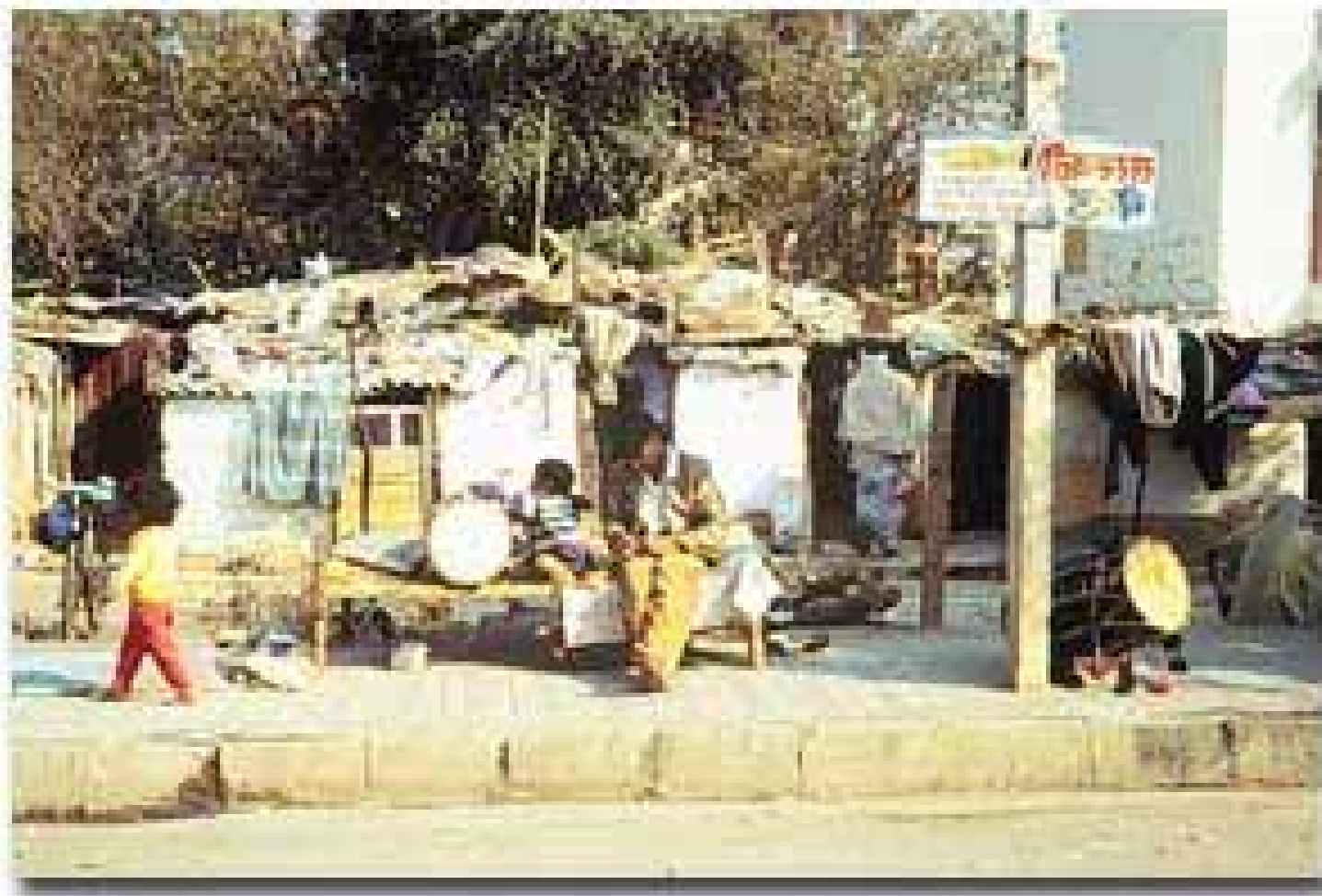

Types of Land for Proclamation

Civil/Military Reservations

(school sites, plazas, government centers, military campsites, agricultural college sites, playgrounds, marketsites, townsites, tourism sites, ect.)



Environmental Reservations

(watersheds, marine parks, national monuments, bird or wildlife sanctuaries, forest reserves, etc.)



Land Proclamation

It is a specific proclamation reserving a portion of the public domain or a portion of a patrimonial government property for a specific purpose or use.



So how does the Executive go about proclaiming lands?

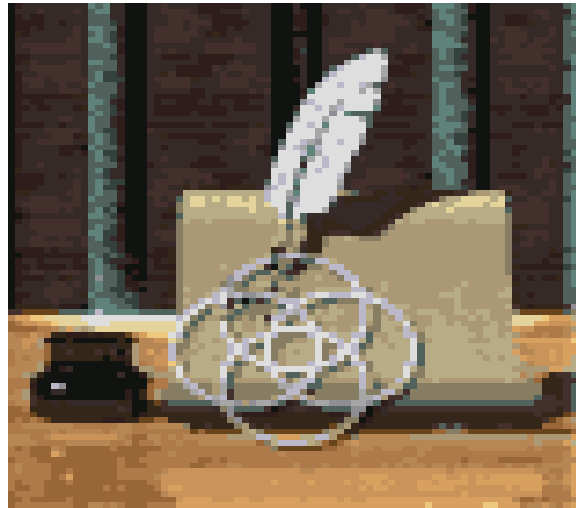
First, we evaluate *motu proprio* or upon petition or request of stakeholders the suitability for socialized housing purposes of certain government-owned lands.



Second, we undertake consultation/ coordination with occupant families, local government units, agency-administrator, reservee or owner, and other stakeholders.



Third, we prepare the draft instrument and submit it to the President.



Fourth, if the President approves, then the proclamation is born.



The **Bonifacio Heights** in Fort Bonifacio, Taguig, which will have two thousand one hundred (2,100) units on a seven (7) hectare area, will cater to the housing needs of military personnel.
